
24th May Day of the Bulgarian Alphabet, Education and Culture

Some additional facts about the Cyrillic alphabet

- Used by 400 million people and over 50 languages around the world today (Bulgarian, Byelorussian, Macedonian, Russian, Serbian, Ukrainian and some others).
- The Cyrillic is the official alphabet of 12 countries.
- 15 % of the world's population are educated using the Cyrillic alphabet
