PHOTO COMPETITION

How can your cultural treasure be presented in a picture?

Take a particularly good photo of your chosen cultural treasure. You can submit up to three photos.

The best hotos will be rewarded with prizes and shown in an exhibition.

Send photos in good quality (min. 1080 pixels) in .jpg or .png format in the size of 1- $4\,\mathrm{MB}$.



VIDEO COMPETITION

Would you like to, alone or as a group, present your cultural treasure in a video?

Make a short video (max. 3 min) about your cultural treasure. You can talk about your cultural treasure, show it actively or present it in a creative way, the best of the submitted videos will receive a prize.

The language can be English or your mother tongue. Please submit the spoken text also in written form.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

To take part in all competitions, you must first submit a "personal cultural treasure" (form A) or select one of the cultural treasures from the gallery on the condanec.eu website. Submission of texts in your mother tongue and English to info@ileu.net by 31.05.2020.

Each entry (texts, photos, videos) must be accompanied by a completed entry form with title, date of recording and description. With his/her signature, the participant must certify that he/she owns the copyrights of the texts, photos and video and has obtained the consent of the persons depicted. Forms at codanec.eu "Call for Participation".

By submitting the form, the participants allow ILEU e.V. to use the photos in the electronic and printed media and in the context of public exhibitions. Videos will be uploaded on the YouTube ILEU channel and will be linked to the project website (codanec.eu).
